Entry requirements:

Candidates will have:

- be a graduate and/or have an initial teaching qualification
- at least two years' full time (1,200 hours) experience of teaching English to adults within the past five years
- a range of teaching experience involving work in different teaching contexts and experience of teaching adults at different levels
- an appropriate awareness of language and language competence in English to enable them to follow the course and complete all assessed elements successfully
- Candidates will also need to be involved in ELT teaching on a regular basis and ensure that for formal assessment purposes there are at least 5 students in the group

7th September 2010 to 25th November 2010

Timetable:

Every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 5.30 p.m. to 8.30 p.m.

Fees:

- 2010 course fees are £ 1,500 plus the Cambridge ESOL examination fees for Module One and Module Two (£ 250)
- £ 300 deposit to be paid on enrolment. This deposit is not refundable, unless you are not accepted on the course
- the balance to be paid at least one week before the start of the course
