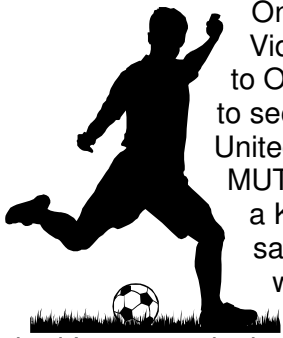

On Friday night I met my friend and went to a pub to drink some beer and chat. We met other friends and then we went to a club.



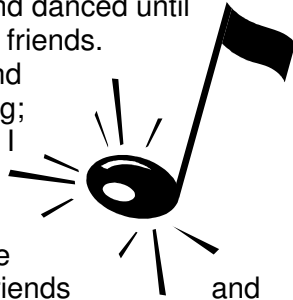
